Opening and Approval of the Agenda

COMMITTEE OLYMPICS SUMMARY

- Internal Officer Serin updated the attending members on the Committee Olympics rankings and announced the current frontrunner, the Student Support Committee, followed by the Academic Committee and Public Relations Secretariat. She congratulated the Student Support Committee and thanked all committee heads and members for their work thus far. She reminded the present working members to create events, attend General Assemblies, and submit their proposals on time to score points in the Committee Olympics.

COMMITTEE INTRODUCTIONS

- Internal Officer Serin introduced the new Audit Council members, who were all present at the General Assembly. She announced that the Council will be drafting a report on the financial status of the organization and the Treasury's functioning which will be presented during the next General Assembly.
- Internal Officer Serin introduced the Graduation Committee, which is in charge of producing the yearbooks and graduation party for this academic year. She announced that applications are open and available in the organization's Instagram description, and encouraged attendees to join.
- The Vice-president introduced the upcoming Board elections, opened the floor for attendee's questions, and announced that the Election Committee had already been formed. The President discussed how the body is endowed with the responsibility of drafting the election guidelines, which he mentioned the Committee would be completing and sharing soon. He also shared that a Board Interest Borrel would take place in the upcoming weeks, where those interested in joining next year's board would have the opportunity to ask questions and know more about the different board positions.

BUDGET UPDATES

- The Treasurer conducted a budget overview, summarizing the state of different committees' budgets. He noted that thus far operations are proceeding well, with revenue generated and limited expenditure. He encouraged the different committees to reach out if more support was needed for any upcoming activities or projects.

PARTNERSHIPS

- The External Officer introduced to the members the upcoming 80s themed party collaboration with Custodia and Fortuna taking place in PIP, the Building Bridges event with LUC and Wijnhaven meant for meeting people from other study programs, and the upcoming rowing clinic with SPIL and Pelargos.
- The External Officer updated the attendees that the year-long partnership with De Corner was now changing to 2.20 euros, and reminded them to present their LU card and CIROS sticker to be able to claim the discount. She also reminded the General Assembly about the on-going yearly partnership with Frenchies, which consists of a 20% discount on their burgers and a free side for CIROS members.
- The Vice-President and the External Officer together introduced other upcoming events such as a first-years study session in partnership with SPIL, a Latin America trivia night, sustainable fashion workshops and potentially a fashion show in collaboration with UNICEF, and a future museum visit event that is still to be defined.
